Utah Archaeology Week Contest Rules

- Each poster must be the work of one student, one entry per person.
- Depiction of dinosaurs will automatically disqualify entry.
- No pre-designed posters, ie no posters with the title, boarder, theme or sponsors.
- The poster concept and design and any photos or artwork used must be the original work of the student/person entering.
- Posters - No larger than 16 by 24 inches.
- If charcoal, pastels or glitter are used, the poster must be either laminated or covered with clear plastic.
- Entry form must accompany each entry.
- Flat shipping or hand delivery to the Rio Grande is recommended for the poster's protection.
- Entries must be received by January 16, 2015.
- Posters will be judged on overall impact, effectiveness in conveying the theme, originality and artistic merit. Judges' decisions are final.
- No Utah state employee entries.
- If you are a past winner, you cannot win for another five years.
- All entries become the property of Utah Division of State History – Antiquities Section.
- Pick up artwork on May 2, 2015 after the Open House, NO EXCEPTIONS. Remaining artwork will not be saved.
