The scholarship is for a stipend up to \$300 meant to off-set travel and lodging costs for recipients traveling into Salt Lake City. The scholarship also covers the recipient's full registration fee. Preference will be given to museum professionals from rural area museums and to individuals who are full-time, permanent staff or volunteers who can illustrate how this workshop will assist their museum in the long-term. Scholarship recipients will be asked to submit any documentation that their museum has developed as a direct result of this workshop, and provide feedback to the Division of Arts and Museums to assist in developing future training opportunities.
