

2014 EXHIBITION PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The Rio & Alice Galleries were created as a service to Utah artists. They provide a free venue for emerging as well as established artists to collaborate on exhibits, participate in the process of producing an exhibit, and engage the community through art making and dialogue. Both galleries participate in the monthly Salt Lake Gallery Stroll and host public receptions on Gallery Stroll evenings.

SPACE

- Rio Gallery: Located in the Historic Rio Grande Depot. Up to thirteen 8'h x 12'w walls and up to fourteen pedestals (varying sizes) for 3D work.
- Alice Gallery: Walls are 83" high, please visit alicegallery.org for full dimensions.
- Two-55" plasma screens for video, web based and digital works.

ELIGIBILITY

We welcome proposals from artists, arts organizations, and independent curators age 18 and over. These include small group shows of two to eight artists or larger curated exhibits. All mediums are accepted. At this time we only accept group proposals -- no solo exhibits. All work must be original -- no reproductions. We accept proposals twice-yearly. If you are unable to submit online for any reason, please call our office for alternatives.

REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements can be uploaded in our online registration process at: <https://utahartsmuseums.submittable.com/submit/23524>

- Exhibition description and/or group statement with list of ALL artists proposed.
- Resume or C.V. of curator **and** bios for participating artists. (Call our office for guidance if exhibiting more than 15 artists).
- Digital images of proposed work for exhibition, or recent work that is representative.

EXHIBITION SELECTION

The visual arts committee will review and select proposals for the gallery. Quality, completion and clarity of the proposal as well as media, reach, and content submitted will all be considered. You must specify if any works have exhibited in other Salt Lake venues up to one year prior. The committee reserves the right to make final decisions on which works will be placed on exhibit. You can request to exhibit in either gallery but the committee might suggest one gallery over the other as being more appropriate for your proposal.

SALES

The galleries do not handle sales transactions and do not take a commission. All sale inquiries are referred to the artist. Work does not have to be for sale.
