

2015 EXHIBITION PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The Rio & Alice Galleries were created as a service to Utah artists and the community at large. They provide a free venue for emerging as well as established artists to collaborate on exhibitions, participate in the process of producing an exhibit, and engage the community through art making and dialogue. Both galleries participate in the monthly Salt Lake Gallery Stroll and host public receptions on Gallery Stroll evenings. Exhibitions may run from 5-8 weeks each. A \$200 artist support fee is available per exhibition.

SPACE

- Rio Gallery: Located in the historic Rio Grande Depot. Up to thirteen 8'h x 12'w walls and up to fourteen pedestals (varying sizes) for 3D work. Apx. 3,300 Sq. Ft.
- Alice Gallery: Apx. 455 sq ft. Walls 83" high. Visit alicegallery.org for full dimensions.
- We have limited variety of audio, video and projection equipment for video, web based and digital works are available for use. Please call with questions on feasibility of other installations.

ELIGIBILITY

We welcome proposals from artists, arts organizations, and independent curators age 18 and over. These include solo exhibitions (Alice Gallery only), small group shows, or larger curated exhibits. All visual arts media including new genres are accepted. All work must be original.

HOW TO APPLY

The following requirements should be uploaded in our online registration process at: utahartsmuseums.submittable.com

- Exhibition description and/or group statement with list of ALL artists proposed.
- Resume or C.V. of curator **and/or** bios for participating artists. (bio exceptions can be made for large groups).
- Digital images of proposed work for exhibition, or recent work that is representative.

We accept proposals twice-yearly. If you are unable to submit online for any reason, please call our office for assistance. Call if you are in need of suggestions for artists to exhibit with.

EXHIBITION SELECTION


The visual arts committee will review and select proposals for the gallery. Quality, completion and clarity of the proposal as well as media, reach, and content submitted will all be considered. Please specify if any works have exhibited in other Salt Lake venues up to one year prior. The committee reserves the right to make final decisions on which works will be placed on exhibit. You can request to exhibit in either gallery but the committee might suggest one gallery over the other as being more appropriate for your proposal. Proposals not accepted will be considered for the next submission review period.

All sales inquiries are referred to artists. 100% of sales to artists. Work can be NFS.
